	Sierra Wireless' AM/AMM management system integrates Google Maps functionality to provide several map-based reports and other features.	
	Google is releasing a new version of their Google Maps API (v3.54) in mid-August 2023. At that time, some AM/AMM map-based reports (e.g., Coverage Trails) will no longer display due to compatibility issues. This issue will not affect the Map or Tracker features of AM or AMM. We are providing a permanent solution to this issue in AM/AMM 2.17.5. As 2.17.5 will not be released until after the August 2023 deadline, this bulletin provides directions that customers can follow to implement a temporary workaround on the AM/AMM. This workaround is supported until April 2024, after which it will require the permanent fix to AM/AMM that is delivered in AM/AMM 2.17.5. We encourage all customers to upgrade to AM/AMM 2.17.5 as soon as it is available.
